For more than 15 years, Syl has been recognized for his commercial and fine art photography. In addition to the award-winning catalogs he published for Arena Roses, Syl's rose photography has appeared in *Sunset*, *Martha Stewart Baby*, *the New York Times*, *Garden Compass*, *Ortho's All About Roses* and many other publications. He has worked as the freelance creative director for Star Roses since 2006. Last fall, Syl created photo portfolios for two of the three firms introducing All-America Rose Selection winners for 2009. Other client's include Nor'East Miniature Roses, Proven Winners and Edmunds' Roses.

The Workshop

The workshop will present information valuable to photographers at all levels. Concepts will be oriented to digital photography – but applicable to film cameras as well. Syl will provide an overview of how the camera's vision differs from our vision so that we can understand why our photos often don't look like what we saw. He will illustrate a number of botanic photography concepts by showing images and the set-ups used to make the images. Syl will also do a live demonstration that projects what the camera is seeing by using the latest digital camera gear from Canon. An illustrated handout will be provided to all participants.

Workshop participants are encouraged to submit up to five of their own digital photographs via email.
